The 11 modules were developed from the Manager Induction Standards and cover the following topics:



Leadership & Management module

Leadership & management in adult care, Action centred leadership and Developing trust.

Governance & Regulatory Process module

Key drivers, Care Quality Commission, Nominated Individuals, Regulation process and Why governance?

Communication module

Communicating effectively, Information and Information sharing.

Relationships and Partnerships module

Partnership working, Managing relationships and Working with carers.

Person-centred Practice for Positive Outcomes module

Person-centred care, Leading person-centred practice, Diversity, equality & inclusion and Continuous quality improvement.

Professional Development module

Development, Developing core skills, Professional supervision and Managing performance.

Resources module

Managing resources, Recruitment & retention and Performance management.

Safeguarding, Protection & Risk module

Safeguarding & protection, Responsibilities, Risk & confidentiality and Restrictive practices.

Manage Self module

Self-awareness, No show!, Workload management, Lead by example and Your vision.

Decision Making module

Making decisions, Information, Meet Rhona, Post decisions and Review decisions.

Entrepreneurial Skills and Innovation module

What is an entrepreneur?, Market provision, Importance of vision and Change management.

Each interactive module will support the learner to increase knowledge, build confidence in the workplace and provide opportunity to reflect on their own work. They'll encourage the learner to implement their learning in the workplace and improve on their own practice and drive change. The modules also provide extended learning opportunities by sign-posting out to further information to help develop strong leadership skills.

The modules will take between 20 to 40 minutes to complete and this can be done at a time and a pace to suit the learner. They're simple and engaging to follow and are relevant across different services and settings.

Each module costs just £10 or you can purchase the full suite for £75, that's a saving of £35 against the individual module price.
