

Adults ASYE – Pre-registration application 2018-19

Notes for employers in local authority, NHS, Community Interest Company (CIC) and social enterprise settings

The deadline for this pre-registration application is 6 July 2018. All employers in local authority, NHS, CIC and social enterprise settings are asked to make a pre-registration application.

This application requires an estimation of the number of newly qualified social workers (NQSWs) your organisation may wish to register during financial year. It's anticipated that this number will take account of:

1. any plans you have to specifically recruit NQSWs
2. any non-specific vacancies that may become available during the year with the possibility that they may be filled by an NQSW.

In order to submit as accurate an estimate as possible this calculation should be based on your organisational workforce planning. Those employers that have signed up to [National Minimum Data Set for Social Care](#) (NMDS-SC) will have access to valuable data to help with this via their individualised NMDS-SC [Dashboards](#).

We have [information and guidance](#) to support workforce planning.

Funding will only be drawn down if and when your first NQSW is registered. Funding **will not** be available for those employers who **miss the pre-registration application deadline**. This is to ensure that we can confirm the initial milestone allocation for all employers. **All local authority, NHS, CIC and social enterprise sector employers should complete this form.**

We would encourage local authorities and partnerships to support employers in the private and voluntary sector to register their NQSWs themselves as the funding allocation can be calculated to reflect the needs of smaller employers. We continue to encourage larger employers to support NQSWs in the private and voluntary sector.

Notes for employers in the private and voluntary sector

The deadline for this pre-registration application is 11 January 2019.

Applications won't be accepted after this date. We would however encourage employers to submit this application as soon as possible to assist our planning for funding allocations across the sector.
